Rules of Conduct

While in the library, the following are prohibited:

- Attempting to take any item from the library without properly checking the item out.
- Smoking or use of tobacco products.
- Verbal or physical abuse of other patrons or staff.
- Sexual misconduct, such as exposure, offensive touching, or sexual harassment of other patrons or staff.
- Bringing in animals other than those authorized by the ASUTR Security Office.
- Disruptive or unsafe behavior, such as loud talking, screaming, slamming doors, running, fighting, throwing things.
- Engaging in any activity prohibited by law or any conduct that unreasonably interferes with others' use of the library.
- Failing to comply with reasonable staff requests.

Possible consequences for violations:

- Warning from staff.
- Staff will ask patrons to leave the library.
- Henderson State University security will be called in to investigate the matter.

Eligibility

Members of the Malvern/ Hot Springs community, alumni, and retired faculty or staff are eligible for community patron cards.

Identification Requirements

To apply for a community patron card, patrons must provide a government issued picture ID, email account, and current address.

Borrowing Items

Community patrons may borrow up to five print materials, per household, at a time for 2 weeks. They are allowed to check out 2 DVDs for a loan period of 5 days. Print materials are allowed 2 renewals past the first checkout date.

Fines

Fines vary depending on the material borrowed. Borrowers are responsible for all materials checked out on their account.

Books \$0.25 cents per day DVDs \$1 per day

Printing

Community patrons can only print in B&W on single sheets for \$0.25 per page.
